Any strong intermediate skier or snowboarder, with or without a disability, 15 years or older, who is interested in teaching persons with disabilities about the "joys" of skiing or snowboarding may take this course.

The CADS Ski Level 1 complete certification is for candidates interested in learning how to teach students across all four disciplines – Autism & Cognitive Impairment, Visual Impairment, Sitski and 3-4 Track. Candidates will learn tools and skills to safely and competently teach skiing to students of all abilities at a beginner level.
